

## **DAILY CHECK ROUTINE FOR SAILING**

You should do a routine check of your boat every day. This list is not a comprehensive, complete list, but may serve as a guide and could be complemented with items important for the type of boat you have chartered.

### **ENGINE BEFORE SAILING**

- ✓ Check engine oil level and engine water level. Visually check the engine area for signs of coolant, fuel or engine oil leaks, broken or loose belts.
- ✓ Check fuel level and make a note of consumption since last control.

### **ENGINE DURING OPERATION**

- ✓ Keep an eye on oil pressure, water temperature, charging volts and fuel levels.
- ✓ Check immediately after starting the engine and periodically while it is running, that the water is coming out of the exhaust.

### **DURING SAILING**

- ✓ Inspect the bilges. If needed use the bilge pump to empty out the water.
- ✓ Check the level of the water tanks.
- ✓ Check the stove fuel level.
- ✓ Ensure that the main anchor is available for immediately use.
